Water Treatment Plant
Maintenance Technician

The City of Clanton is seeking to fill a full-time hourly position. The Water Treatment Plant Maintenance Technician is responsible for performing Plant maintenance activities and maintaining equipment.

Duties include but are not limited to:

The Water Treatment Maintenance Technician performs routine and heavy manual work of a semi-skilled nature. May use simple hand tools and equipment as well as heavy equipment/machinery.

Essential Functions

- Grounds maintenance (i.e., mowing, edging, trimming, planting) at plant, water towers and river pumps.
- Assists Operators with inspections of water/wastewater treatment plant processes and equipment operations.
- Performs cleaning, repair, and maintenance tasks to keep plant in good condition, specifically: cleaning building, floors, and restrooms, and replacing light bulbs.
- Operates vehicles, machinery, equipment, and tools in performance of assigned duties; specifically: tractors, mowers, weed eaters, mechanics' tools, carpenters' tools, and shovels.
- Performs maintenance on vehicles and landscaping equipment, specifically: checking fluids, belts and tires and repairing electric motors.
- Assists with storm drain covers for street department.
- Changes oil in pumps, lubricates pumps, paints lines, and keeps facilities clean.
- Picks up parts and supplies; loads/unloads equipment and supplies; changes chlorine cylinders.
- Drains and pressure washes basins and filters.
- Performs other duties as assigned.

Required Education and Experience

- High school diploma or GED strongly preferred, but not required.
- Possess a current and valid Alabama Driver's License.
- Minimum of two (2) years prior experience in a similar field preferred, but not required.

Working Conditions

The work condition characteristics describe here are representatives of those an employee encounters while performing the essential functions of this position. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- Working conditions are indoors as well as the field environment with exposure to noise, dust, heat, cold, rain, and other inclement weather conditions.
- Working environment is indoor and outdoor setting with periods of heavy workloads in which multitasking is required.

- General physical and working conditions are such that minor cuts, abrasions, bruises, or burns may be encountered with various jobs.
- Work environment can be dirty with unpleasant odors.
- Frequently works near moving mechanical parts.
- Frequently exposed to toxic, caustic, and acidic chemicals and gases.
- Occasionally exposed to fumes, airborne particles, risk of electric shock, vibration, and loud noise due to pumps, etc.
- Occasionally works in confined spaces.
- Mandatory overtime is sometimes required.
- Must be available to work nights, weekends, and holidays.
Shift schedule is subject to change without notice.

Physical Requirements

The physical requirements described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this position. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- Must possess the ability to access remote sites that may require climbing and traversing rough terrain, possibly in all weather conditions.
- Must be able to drive a vehicle to oversee projects, perform inspections, respond to after-hour calls, and other functions as needed. Must be able to sit, stand and walk for extended periods of time while working in office or on maintenance or repair projects.
- Must be able to use stepstools or ladders and use such to store and retrieve items of various sizes, shapes, and forms.
- Lift and/or carry up to or over 50 pounds, and pull, push, or drag up to or over 150 pounds of files, equipment and/or other materials.

Education/Experience

High school diploma or general education degree (GED) plus two (2) years related experience and/or training in a similar field is highly preferred, but not a requirement; or equivalent combination of education and experience in construction, equipment operation, or commercial landscaping is preferred, but not a requirement.

Annual compensation begins at \$24,876.80. Depending on experience, education, and other training, higher rates of pay will be considered. **The City of Clanton is proud to offer an excellent benefits package.**

Applicant must satisfactorily pass a background investigation and pre-employment drug screen after receiving a conditional offer of employment.
